

Petro-Cepeda: 3,949.159 million Votes Cast at Gunpoint

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On July 10, 2026, the NTN24 program *La Noche* revealed a complaint filed with Colombia's Attorney General alleging that armed group coercion illegally steered nearly 4 million votes to Iván Cepeda. Armed with data from the *Fundación Misión Colombia Transparente*, the network interviewed the whistleblowers behind the criminal complaint exposing this alleged pattern of electoral manipulation¹.

The Colombian electorate in conflict-affected regions presents a harrowing account of the 2026 electoral cycle. Locals assert that, "with a gun to the back of their necks," nearly three million voters were coerced by illegal armed groups and organized crime into casting ballots for the Historic Pact in the legislative races and for Iván Cepeda in the presidential contest.

Conversely, President Petro, Senator Cepeda, and the Historic Pact categorically reject these allegations, labeling them as stigmatizing. They maintain that their electoral support reflects the authentic, democratic will of progressive social movements and marginalized rural communities, completely denying any intervention by the criminal syndicates that ostentatiously attended Cepeda's rallies and control the territories where they secured those nearly three million votes.

However, many Colombians strongly counter that both current domestic leadership and international observers—including the United Nations and the European Union—are propagating an unearned narrative. By validating these outcomes, international bodies are effectively legitimizing a "vote-by-rifle" system—an endorsement viewed as a profound insult to the principles of Colombian democracy.

This pattern echoes the 2022 presidential race. According to public statements made by President Petro's own brother and son, criminal organizations weaponized similar tactics of voter coercion to deliver one million votes to Petro. This interference allowed him to secure the presidency by a razor-thin margin while effectively barring his opponent from campaigning during the runoff. Despite these revelations, the global left and their media continue to view Petro's 2022 victory as legitimate.

Petro has essentially co-governed with these illegal armed groups and syndicates through his "Total Peace" deal, cynically dubbed "The Picota [jail] Pact."

Under his administration, the footprint of these organizations has nearly tripled, and Colombia has become the world's leading producer and exporter of cocaine and illegal mining. Flush with illicit wealth, these criminal factions now control approximately 70% of the national territory. Beyond hijacking the ballot box at home, they have installed a reign of terror and extortion across these vast territories—a direct, devastating consequence of Petro-Cepeda's "Total Peace" agenda.

These dirty dollars have also infiltrated the international stage, where Petro and his "Total Peace" associates have spent millions on a sophisticated global propaganda campaign to fabricate successes that simply do not exist. This deceptive lobbying has effectively captured liberal Democrats in the U.S., major media outlets, and European governments like Sweden, Spain, and Portugal, which have been rewarded with dubious, multi-million-dollar contracts.

Meanwhile, President Petro, Vice President Francia Márquez, and their families have collectively taken more than 120 trips abroad, spending millions of dollars funded by Colombian taxpayers. While receiving lavish state honors and having vacations covered by European public funds, international media—particularly in Europe—have worked aggressively to paint Petro and his allies as brave figures, on the one hand.

On the other hand, they aggressively sanitize blood-stained transnational syndicates like the Gulf Clan, Tren de Aragua, the ELN, and the Second Marquetalia—shamelessly rebranding ruthless, multi-million-dollar criminal empires as mere "poor fishing families" or "humble, impoverished young men." Through this disinfected lens, they sustain the narrative that Iván Cepeda's narrow defeat was a close democratic race², falsely legitimized by treating four million coerced ballots as a matter of free choice.

Ultimately, this exposes the global agenda that the Petro government and organized crime have been jointly financing and pushing since 2022.
